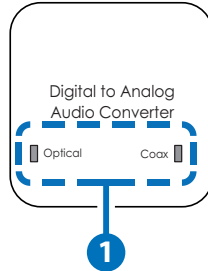

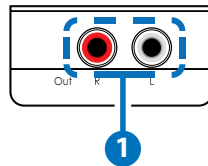
6. OPERATION CONTROLS AND FUNCTIONS

6.1 Top Panel



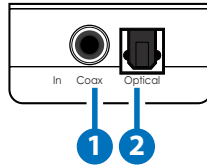
- 1 Optical & Coax LEDs:** These LED lights will illuminate according to which input is currently selected.

6.2 Front Panel



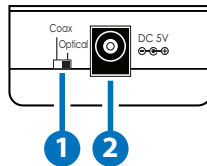
- 1 L/R Out:** Analog stereo output. Connect to the input of your audio device or display.

6.3 Rear Panel



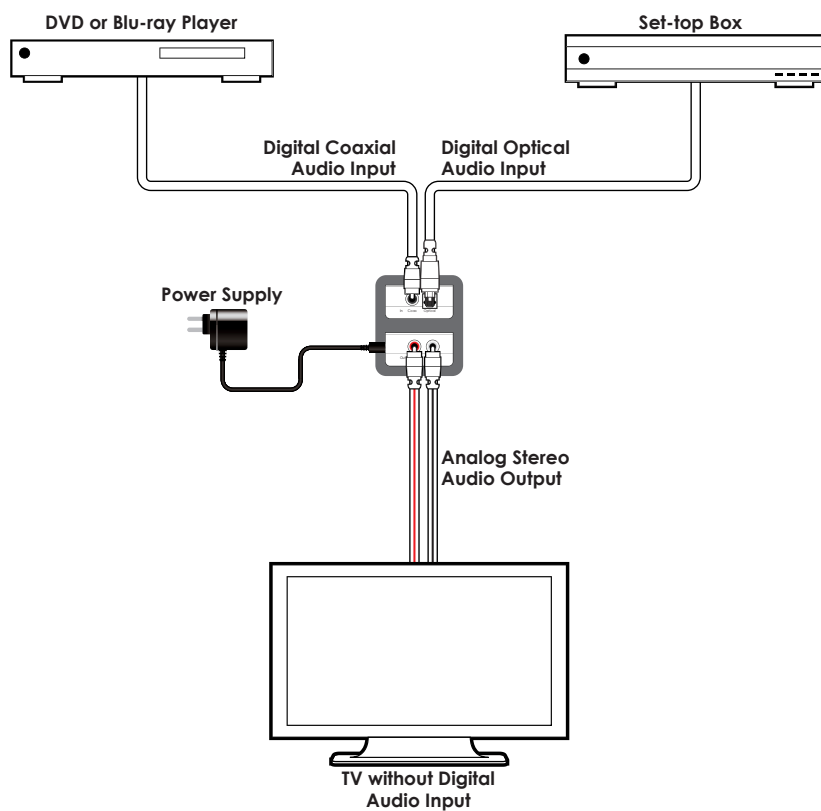
- 1 Coax In:** Connect to the Coaxial digital audio source, such as a DVD player or CD player.
- 2 Optical In:** Connect to the Optical audio source, such as a Blu-ray player or games console.

6.4 Left Panel



- 1 Coax/Optical Switch:** Select which digital audio input is active and will be converted to analog stereo (L/R) audio.
- 2 DC 5V:** Connect the 5V DC power supply to the unit and plug the adaptor into an AC wall outlet.
